



FESTIVAL PREMIO EMILIO LUSSU

ANNOUNCEMENT OF COMPETITION

The Emilio Lussu Festival announces the fourth edition of the “Emilio Lussu Prize” literary contest.

The competition is open to anyone, but minors are required to attach signed parental consent.

COMPETITION

The competition consists of two categories:

- A. Poetry in any language and on any subject, with Italian translation, up to 50 lines.
- B. Fiction (stories) in any language and on any subject, with Italian translation, up to 5 pages (each page — A4 — max 30 lines).

Awards will go to the first three works for each category.

Jury and organizers may give other prizes and honorable mentions.

Winners will be announced during the Festival in Cagliari, 4-7 Oct, 2018.

Time and place of the award ceremony will be announced a month before both to the participants and on www.festivalpremioemiliolussu.org

PRIZES

Prizes for both categories, in addition to parchment and plate, consist of:

25 copies for first place;

15 copies for second place;

10 copies for third place,

of the book by the Lussu Prize where awarded poetry and fiction will be published.

DEADLINE

May 20, 2018

HOW TO PARTECIPATE

Both published and unpublished works will be accepted.

Entry fee (for each work): 30 euros.

Each participant can send up to three works for each category.

HOW TO SEND YOUR WORK

Works can be submitted:

1) by mailing a package containing two anonymous copies of the works (with title) and a smaller sealed envelope containing the entirely filled-in entry form with payment receipts attached. At the same time a copy of the work and a payment receipt will need emailing to info@festivalpremioemiliolussu.org

Entry fees must be paid to *C/C bancario* (bank account) no. 19314 made out to Associazione Culturale L'Alambicco, IBAN IT90U010150499900000019314 having as a description of payment: *Partecipazione Premio Emilio Lussu 2018*.

2) If you pay cash, you will only have to send your works, as per 1), by registered mail addressed to: Festival Premio Emilio Lussu c/o Monia Salis Via Pietro Scornigiani 32 09121 Cagliari.

3) By emailing two files (one with text and title, the other one with the completely filled-in entry form) and the payment receipt to info@festivalpremioemiliolussu.org

HOW YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED

The Emilio Lussu Prize organization will tell all the participants the results by email and/or by phone. All the participants are invited to attend the award ceremony during the Festival, 4-7 Oct, 2018, when winners of both categories will be announced.

The first three places for both categories will be notified beforehand, but winners will be known only at the award ceremony.

Winners will have their work published on a book by the Festival organizers.

Authors will be the sole proprietors of their own work's rights.

JURY

Jurors will be poets, writers and national and international artists whose names will be revealed on www.festivalpremioemiliolussu.org and on all the networks used before the award ceremony.

Jury's work is final and unappealable.

Stories and poems selected will be entered and judged anonymously.

The first three places for both categories will be announced during the award ceremony.

Jury will choose, finally and unappealably, 10 works, 5 for each category.

DATA PROTECTION

According to the Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003, the art direction declares that, according to section 13, "Information to data subjects", personal data treatment is only intended for the prize and the forwarding of future announcements of competition; furthermore they declare that participants, by submitting their work, authorize the use of their personal data; moreover they declare that, according to section 7, "Right to Access Personal Data and Other Rights",
